

# Privacy Policy

## About us

The “Aberdeen Camera Club” was founded in 1889 as the “Aberdeen Photographic Association” and operated under that title until 1964 when it was renamed. Since the early days the main aim of the Club has been to encourage and promote mainly amateur photographers in the pursuit of their hobby.

## What we collect and how we use it

Aberdeen Camera Club collects information that you give us when you use our website, online community, contact us by e-mail or in some other way or participate in Club events. This information may include name, contact details (e-mail address, telephone number, postal address), records of entries to events, photographs on our website, and such other information as may be necessary for the effective management of the legitimate interests of the Aberdeen Camera Club. You may apply to the Club Secretary to correct or update the information we hold.

The contact details of elected officials of the Club may be published in our Programme of Events, on our website or as legitimately required to provide the services of their office.

We collect anonymous data when you visit our website which is used for statistical purposes only.

You have an option as a member of our Club to join our online “Slack community” ([aberdeencameraclub.slack.com](https://aberdeencameraclub.slack.com)). This service is provided by Slack and requires you to become a user of the Slack service. ## Data Retention

We hold personally identifiable data for as long as you are a member of the Club in order to provide the benefits of membership to you. Membership of the Club is renewed annually. Some data may be held for longer if there is a legal obligation to do so.

The Club will not sell or pass on to third parties the data we hold about you unless there is a legal obligation to do so.
